

MOST POPULAR EXCURSIONS IN THE PROVINCE OF CASTELLON



HALF DAY VISIT TO PEÑISCOLA:

- Reception of the group in the port esplanade.
- Explaining the walled complex.
- Tour of the winding streets of Peñíscola, visit to the Museum of the Sea.
- Visit to the castle built by the Templars in the fifteenth century, and residence of Pope Luna. (Groups + 30 pax = 4.50 €/pax)
- At the end of the visit, free time for shopping



HALF DAY VISIT TO MORELLA:

- Reception of the group in San Miguel Towers.
- Tour of the city center. Explanation of the Town Hall from the outside (Europa Nostra Prize, in 1997, for its restoration), arcaded street by D. Blasco de Alagón (13th century) and ancestral homes.
- Visit to the Archpriestal Basilica of Santa María la Mayor.
- Explanation of the Castle Fortress, from a viewpoint, free ascent.

Entrance fee Basilica + Museum = 3 €/pax.



HALF DAY VISIT TO THE CAPITAL: CASTELLÓN:

- Meeting with the group at an agreed point.
- Visit to the Basilica of Lledó.
- Visit to the Fine Arts Museum.
- Walking tour through the centre of Castellón, visiting the Cathedral of Santa Maria. (Entrance fee).

NOTE: If the group has bus and time we can make a panoramic view of the sea area EL GRAU.

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HALF DAY VISIT TO SEGORBE:

- Reception of the group at the "Monument to the Entrance of the Bullring"
- Visit to the Town Hall, 16th Century Ducal Palace
- Tour of the walled area.
- Visit to the Municipal Museum of Archaeology and Ethnology.
- Medieval Aqueduct and Botxi Tower.

NOTE: Cathedral entrance price and museum: 3,50 €



HALF DAY VISIT TO OROPESA DEL MAR:-

We recommend a guided walking tour of the Old Town and a guided bus tour of its beaches and municipality.

In the Old Town you can visit its Muslim Castle and its charming narrow streets.

Also in this area are the following museums:

Naturhiscope:- Mediterranean Interpretation Centre (Closed on Sundays).
Group price = 2,50 €/pax.

Museo del Naípe (Playing Card Museum):- Price 3 €/pax in groups.

Iron Museum:- 3 €/pax. in groups. Situated on top of a hill, it has typical narrow streets that lead to the castle.



HALF DAY VISIT TO VILLAFAMÉS

Situated on top of a hill. It has typical narrow streets that lead to the castle of Arab origin that dominates the town. The town has points of interest such as the Ermita de la Sangre (17th century) and the Church of the Assumption (16th century), which has a beautiful sample of Alcora pottery.

Museum of Contemporary Art in the Casa del Batle (XIV-XV), houses an important collection of works by Miró, Gargallo, Cuixart, etc.
