

MURCIA & CARTAGENA (4h)



Leaving Cartagena, the route into the hinterland first crosses fertile farming plains before winding through the pass of the “Mountains of the Chain” to reach Murcia, the charming capital of the province.

In the heart of the “Old Quarter” of the city, the XIII century Cathedral is visited. The main façade is considered to be one of the best examples of baroque architecture in Spain. In the interior the stone tracery of the late gothic “Velez Chapel” delights the visitor.

On returning to Cartagena the panoramic walking tour of the city, beautifully situated on the superb natural harbour, starts with a stroll past the monument to the Heroes of Cavite and the Town Hall and then continues along the pedestrian “Main Street” to admire the 18TH century doorway of the Casino and the Part of excavated seen below panels.

An interesting stop is Roman Theatre, 1987. The rows of the Hill of the commemorative was built in the late maximum urban Colony.



made at the site of the discovered by chance in seats were built into the side Conception. The descriptions indicate that it 1st century B.C., the period of development in the Roman Colony.


